Aftercare Instructions – Caring for the Procedure Area

After care is very important to achieve a beautiful and lasting result.

After care plan for eyeliner

Day 1:

- Clean only with cool, set cloth.
- No soaps!
- Apply ointment every morning and evening for first 10 days.
- Wipe on and then wipe off!
- Don't leave thick ointment sitting on liner.
- Apply 10 minute ice pack and sleep on back elevated.

Some clients take a benadryl for puffiness when they go to bed the first night.

The first 10 days of care:

- No soaps or cleaners on treated area for 10 days.
- No makeup on treated area. You may wear NEW mascara on tips of lashes.
- No swimming or sunning for 10 days.
- Apply ointment twice daily for 10 days after cleaning with a wet cloth.
- DO NOT PICK at any flaking skin.
- No ice packs after day 2.
- Use eye drops if desired.

Healing schedule for eyeliner:

- Day 1: Swollen, like you've been crying with a heavier eye makeup look.
- Day 2: Swollen, usually for only a few hours after waking up, with the heavier eye makeup look continuing.
- Day 3: Swelling decreases with a tight feeling. The pigment begins to lift away from the skin.
- Day 4: There is a pinching feeling, some itching is normal as the skin begins to flake. DO NOT pick at it.
- Day 5: Blinking movements of the eye usually removes all pigment by this day. Color is somewhat lighter and will take a few more days to clarify to full color.
